The story: Sudhir Mishra's latest film "Inkaar" lets us watch Rahul and his protégé Maya as they engage into a battle for a job at an ad agency. The events take a dramatic turn when Maya files a sexual harassment complaint against Rahul and suddenly the question arises whose story is the truth... or whether either of them is.

More about the story: Rahul Verma is a ladies' man. It merely takes him a smile and women will hang on his lips, literally and figuratively. Working successfully for one of India's biggest ad firms, he meets Maya Luthra at an advertising festival, where she and her friends have just failed to win the award for the year's best campaign. Rahul's interest is piqued when he spots beautiful Maya - he offers to take her under his wings. Sexual tension between the two of them is tangible and neither is able nor willing to withstand, all the while Maya rises to a high position in Rahul's firm, thanks to his teaching. But when a job offer puts them on opposite sites, Maya suddenly claims to have been sexually harassed by Rahul. Now it is for a committee to find out who is right and who is lying. How will the agency deal with having to choose between their two most talented employees? And who - or what - will turn out to be the real victim of their war?
